Harm Reduction during the Pandemic

Dr. Sue is the Medical Director of the Harm Reduction Coalition, a national advocacy and capacity-building organization that promoted the health and dignity of individuals and communities impacted by drug use and the racialized War on Drugs. Dr. Sue's areas of expertise include examining the intersections of anthropology and clinical medicine, medicine and social justice, and health advocacy for and in solidarity with structurally vulnerable communities. She completed her medical training at Massachusetts General Hospital in Internal Medicine-Primary Care, with a focus on substance use disorders and addiction medicine. She currently sees patients in syringe service programs providing low threshold buprenorphine treatment for opioid use disorder. Additionally, she is an Attending Physician at Rikers Island Correctional Health Services.
